Hazardous Communications Program Training Practical

1. Review Hazardous Communications Program SOP 02-18CW.
2. What is the Hazcom program?
 - Program that contains a list of chemical products present at the facility and describes hazards associated with the normal use of those products.
3. What is the importance of having a Hazcom Program?
 - To keep employees informed of hazards associated with the chemical products they use during the performance of their jobs.
 - To ensure all employees practice safe handling of chemical hazards.
4. Where is the Hazcom program located?
 - In flight deck office on designated desktop computer.
 - On company website: www.carwash808.express
 - In chemical equipment room – physical binder
5. What is a Safety Data Sheet (SDS)?
 - A document that includes information such as the properties of each chemical; the physical health, and environmental health hazards; protective measure; and safety precautions.
 - Have employees name a few topics on SDS:
 - i. Name of Product
 - ii. Physical & Chemical Characteristics
 - iii. Name of Product
 - iv. Physical and Chemical Characteristics
 - v. Physical hazards such as fire potential
 - vi. Health hazards such as symptoms of exposure
 - vii. Routes of entry, i.e. eyes, ears, skin, ingestion, etc.
 - viii. Exposure limits
 - ix. Carcinogenic hazards if any
 - x. Protective measures for use and handling
 - xi. Emergency and First Aid
 - xii. SDS preparation date
 - xiii. Name, address and phone number for more information

6. Who is OSHA?

- Occupational Safety & Health Administration
- A federal agency that establishes on-the-job safety protections for workers
- An important role in our economy, preventing workplace illnesses and injuries

7. Why is OSHA relevant?

- An OSHA inspection applies to all PEI facilities: CarWash808 Express & Pau Hana Express.

8. Why is being educated about the OSHA inspection important?

- 1. Safety!! To ensure safety for our employees, customers, vendors, and guests in our workplace.
- 2. Fines, if these safety policies and regulations aren't being followed there will be large amounts of fines.

OSHA Penalties	
Below are the maximum penalty amounts, with the annual adjustment for inflation, that may be assessed after Jan. 15, 2022. (See OSHA Memo, Jan 13, 2022).	
Type of Violation	Penalty
Serious Other-Than-Serious Posting Requirements	\$14,502 per violation
Failure to Abate	\$14,502 per day beyond the abatement date
Willful or Repeated	\$145,027 per violation

9. Have each employee run through scenarios as if it was an OSHA inspection:

- Ask employee “Does your company have a Hazcom program?”
- Ask employee to take you to their company’s Hazcom program.
- Select a chemical and request the employee to give you the SDS.
- Give an employee a scenario, have them read the first aid measure:
 - Ex: If an employee were to get (chemical) in their (eye, mouth, skin), what would you instruct them to do?
 - Ex: What PPE is required to be worn when handling this chemical?
