Car Wash Tunnel Cleaning Procedures

Through the course of the day there are many policies and procedures we must follow. The following is an outline of steps to be taken when cleaning the Car Wash Tunnel. It is necessary to familiarize yourself with all the details of this SOP.

CAR WASH TUNNEL CLEANING PROCEDURE:

1. The Car Wash Tunnel Cleaning Procedure is meant to be performed daily at the close of operation. It's "EXTREMELY" important to ensure the "Wash Stop Switch" located on the Flight deck is in the "OFF" position before you begin cleaning the wash tunnel.
2. Clear tunnel floors including "Loader" floor mat located at the tunnel entrance.
3. Wash down tunnel walls of any debris. Use squeegee to push all debris to the exit side of tunnel being careful not to allow leaves or trash to enter the wash trough. Push all debris outside the tunnel. Use broom and dust pan to clean up debris.
4. Use the wash tunnel fire hose to rinse down car wash equipment. Ensure brushes and mitts are rinsed down. Note: Certain areas of the wash equipment build up excess dirt or soap. Rinse these areas thoroughly and wipe down as necessary.
5. Wipe down entrance modules using approved cleaner: (Weiman Stainless Steel Cleaner and Polish) and a cloth rag.
6. Remove and place trough covers/grates to one side of the wash tunnel belt. Wash down trough starting at the tunnel entrance moving debris toward the center of the wash tunnel trough. Reinstall covers/grates when finished.
7. Rinse down tunnel floors and squeegee excess water into wash trough.
8. Mop floors using mop bucket to clean and clear excess water from wash tunnel floors. Note: No additional cleaner should be added to mop bucket. "USE WATER ONLY." Never use cleaners or chemicals in the wash tunnel area unless approved by the Operations Manager.
9. Clean and organize storage cabinets. Wipe down tool boxes and organize. Clear any items from top of tool boxes and storage cabinets. Nothing should ever be stored on top of the storage cabinets or any tool box located in the wash tunnel area.

10. Clean and organize equipment/pump room. Ensure no items are stored on top of tanks or wash chemical barrels. Clear work bench counter top and wipe clean. Clean inside and outside of industrial sink and wipe dry. Mop equipment/pump room floors.
11. Empty mop bucket into trough. Return cleaners, mops, squeegees, and mop bucket to their designated areas. NEVER leave cleaners, mops or mop buckets in the wash tunnel area.
