## Car Wash Tunnel Safety Policy

**Purpose:** To ensure all employees are aware of the safety hazards present in the Car Wash tunnel during operation and safety protocols provided below.

### Personal Protective Equipment Required:

- Safety glasses
- Face-shield
- Ear protection
- Nitrile gloves
- Slip-Resistant shoes

### Safe Zone:

Safe Zone is the side of the red line opposite from the Car Wash Tunnel.



### Rules to Follow:

1. You must ALWAYS remain in the safe zone side of the red line within the car wash tunnel when it is operating and ONLY when properly equipped with required PPE. NEVER cross this red line while the car wash is operating.
  - At Waipio Car Wash never go on loader side (driver side) of the tunnel while belt is running, due to the limited space between the wall and the car wash equipment it is not a safe area to be in while in operation.

- At Kapolei Car Wash never stand on loader side (passenger side) of the tunnel while belt is running, due to the limited space between the wall and the car wash equipment it is not a safe area to be in while in operation.
- 2. Absolutely no running.
- 3. Absolutely no horseplay.
- 4. During tunnel operation, when cleaning, be sure to follow red line rule and be aware of your surroundings.
- 5. Never jeopardize your safety or anyone else's safety to retrieve any item, part, equipment, etc. Always adhere to these safety rules and procedures.

**Retrieving Customer Items in Car Wash Tunnel:**

1. While looking for any items in the car wash tunnel during operation, ALWAYS remain in the safe zone side of the red line and ONLY when properly equipped with required PPE.
2. Visually search the Car Wash tunnel while complying with the red line rule.
3. Once you've identified the customers item, alert the Flight Deck Operator to stop the belt.
4. NEVER cross the red line to retrieve any items unless the car wash has been stopped by the Flight Deck Operator.  
NEVER WALK ACROSS THE CAR WASH BELT, BUT ALWAYS AROUND IT.
5. If item is on belt or center grate, hold next vehicle to be loaded and wait until all vehicles on belt complete their wash and exits Car Wash tunnel. However, if item is deemed an obstruction, then stop belt, get customers attention, safely retrieve item, i.e. coolers, bumpers, spare tire covers, etc.
6. Once Car Wash tunnel is clear, stop the belt, then retrieve customer's item.
7. Once employees have cleared the area, start the Car Wash belt, and resume loading vehicles.
